





\* Pharmacy teams are required to send all non-age exempt EPS tokens and all EPS tokens where a prescription charge has been paid to the Pricing Authority for audit purposes. Age exempt EPS tokens must not be submitted.

The EPS token is a legal entity and is used to capture the patient's declaration for prescription charge payment or exemption or remission from prescription charges only. It is not used for payment.

Submitted EPS Tokens must relate to the same dispensing month as the EPS R2 prescriptions submitted to the Pricing Authority for payment.

\*Prescriptions needing to be placed in red separators: broken bulk items, items with a NIC of £100 or more; "specials" (unlicensed medicines/ imports), where the prescriber has provided additional product information, where there are handwritten amendments, where the prescriber's signature encroaches on prescribed items, Out of Pocket expense claims.
