**The Pharmaceutical Services (Fees for Applications)
(Amendment) Directions 2016**

The Secretary of State gives the following Directions in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 131(1) and (2)(a), 272(7) and (8)(a) and 273(1) of the National Health Service Act 2006(a).

The Secretary of State has consulted, in accordance with section 131(3)(a) of that Act, with such organisations as the Secretary of State considers appropriate that appear to the Secretary of State to represent persons providing pharmaceutical services.

Citation, commencement and application

1.—(1) These Directions may be cited as the Pharmaceutical Services (Fees for Applications) (Amendment) Directions 2016 and come into force on 1st December 2016.

(2) These Directions apply in relation to England.

Amendment of Regulation 3 of the Pharmaceutical Services (Fees for Applications) Directions 2013

2. In direction 3 of the Pharmaceutical Services (Fees for Applications) Directions 2013(b) (fees), in sub-paragraph (2)(b)—

(a) omit “or” at the end of sub-paragraph (iv);

(b) add “, or” at the end of sub-paragraph (v); and

(c) after sub-paragraph (v) insert the following sub-paragraph—

“(vi) under regulation 26A(c) (consolidation onto an existing site), £250.”.
