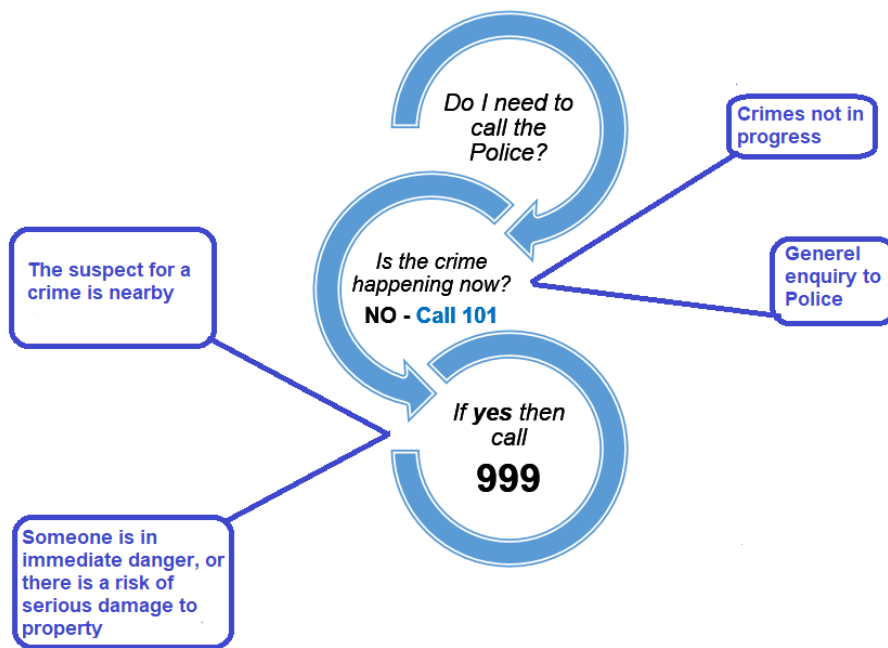


Police Advice for Pharmacies
