About **CP DG**: The Group was formed in 2017 by <u>PSNC</u>, <u>NPA</u>, <u>RPS</u>, <u>CCA</u> and <u>AIMp</u>. The meetings are attended by members representing the five organisations and representatives from pharmacy system suppliers and NHS and health organisations with an interest in pharmacy NHS IT. - provide balanced feedback to support good IT within all types and sizes of pharmacy;
- treat documents confidentially if they are marked as such,
- treat documents confidentially if you are unsure about whether they may be confidential;
- advise a CPDG moderator if you know someone else who might like to join;
- be able to unsubscribe or leave the group at any time, by following instructions at the bottom of the email or contacting a moderator;
- suggest with others a new specialist sub-group to have its own google group email address
 to be setup by CPDG moderator where there is a niche project involving some of the CPDG
 members who need regular and joint contact and many such emails less relevant to wider
 CPDG member inboxes;
- take part in short polls that may crop up if you like; and
- have fun discussing the future.

Your views will help inform Community Pharmacy IT Group (CP ITG) who will in turn pass collated views to PSNC/NHS Digital to help their IT work. The persons within CP ITG also take part with the CPDG.
