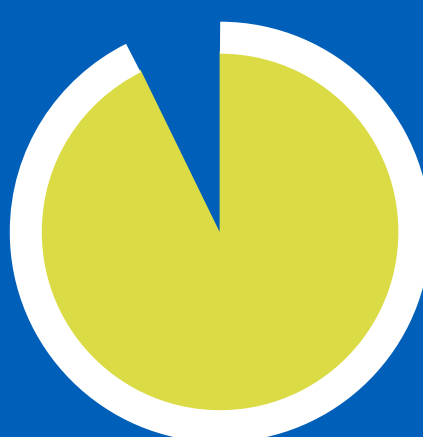


Pharmacy Quality Scheme

- Obtaining urgent supplies



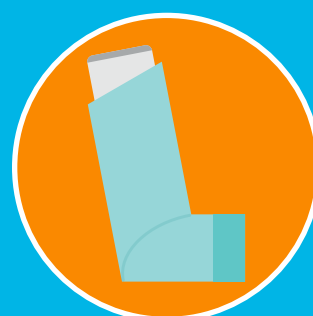
10,556

Digital enablers



***10,799**

pharmacies are able to send and receive NHSmail. Over 40,000 NHSmail accounts have now been rolled out to support confidential communication of patient information and integrate pharmacy into the NHS primary care team



9,749

increased their use of the Summary Care Record to support clinical care. Over 95% of pharmacies now have access to SCR



***10,807**

are enabled to receive and dispense prescriptions via the Electronic Prescription Service



10,654

updated their NHS 111 Directory of Services profile to enable real time referral to community pharmacy to support urgent and self-care

*Gateway criteria required to take part in the scheme. 39 of the 10,809 pharmacies who made a declaration did so stating that they did not meet at least one of the gateway criteria and were not then eligible for payment.
