## Pharmacy endorsing guidance for specials and imported unlicensed medicines

The prescription endorsement requirements for specials and imported unlicensed medicines vary depending on whether a product is listed in the Drug Tariff (Part VIIIB or Part VIIID) but also how the special was sourced. In this factsheet, PSNC's Dispensing and Supply team outline the different endorsement requirements for both Drug Tariff-listed and non-Tariff specials.

<sup>2.</sup> Broken Bulk claims are ONLY permitted for specials listed in Part VIIID. Broken bulk CANNOT be claimed for any Part VIIIB or non-Tariff specials.
