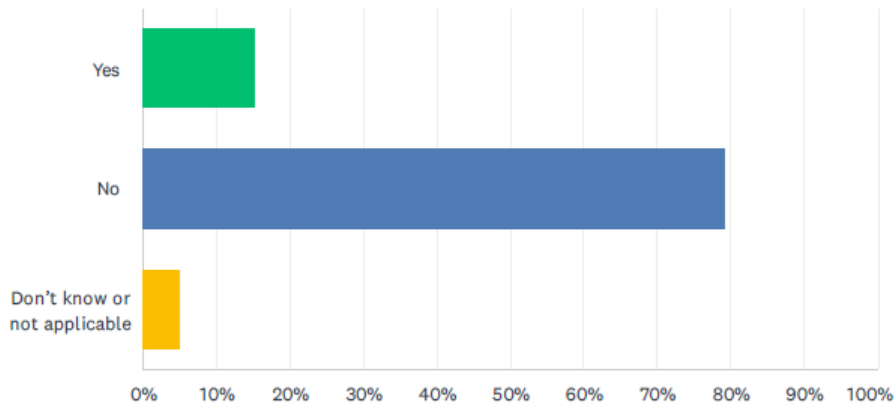


Community Pharmacy IT Group (CP ITG) Results for IT arrangements survey results

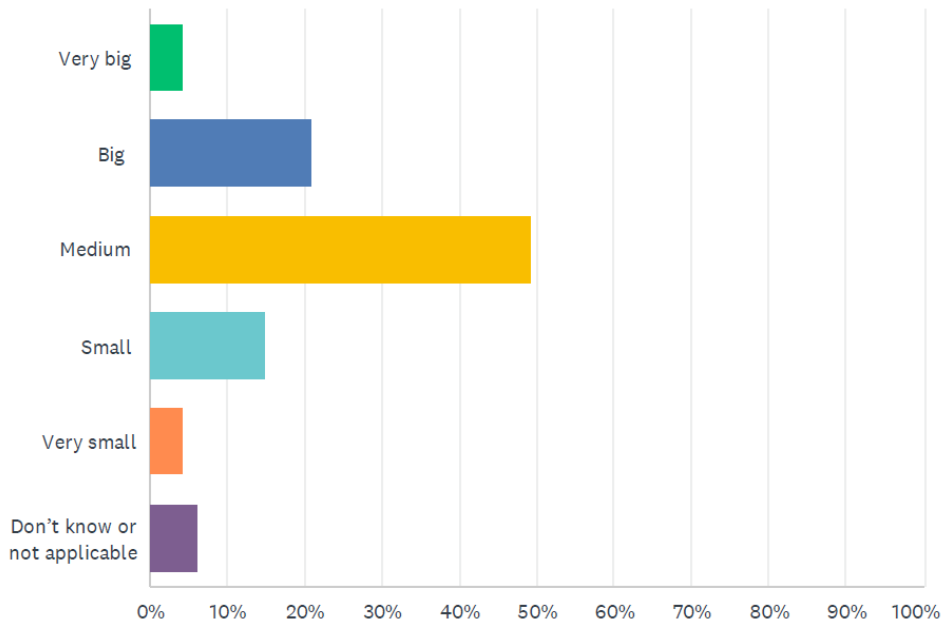
Community Pharmacy conducted a poll of pharmacy contractors and teams about their IT arrangements and CP ITG member organisations promoted it via pharmacy news bulletins and other communication streams. The poll ran from late 2021 and was closed during September 2022. The collated results are outlined here.

Q1 Is your pharmacy located within the same premises as a GP practice?



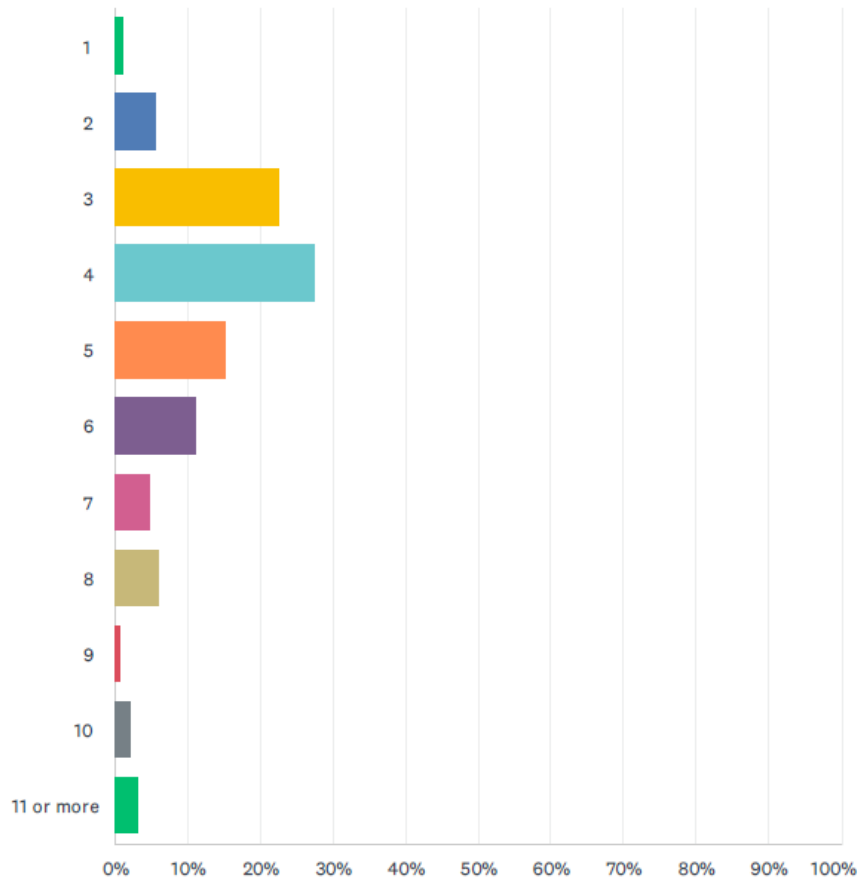

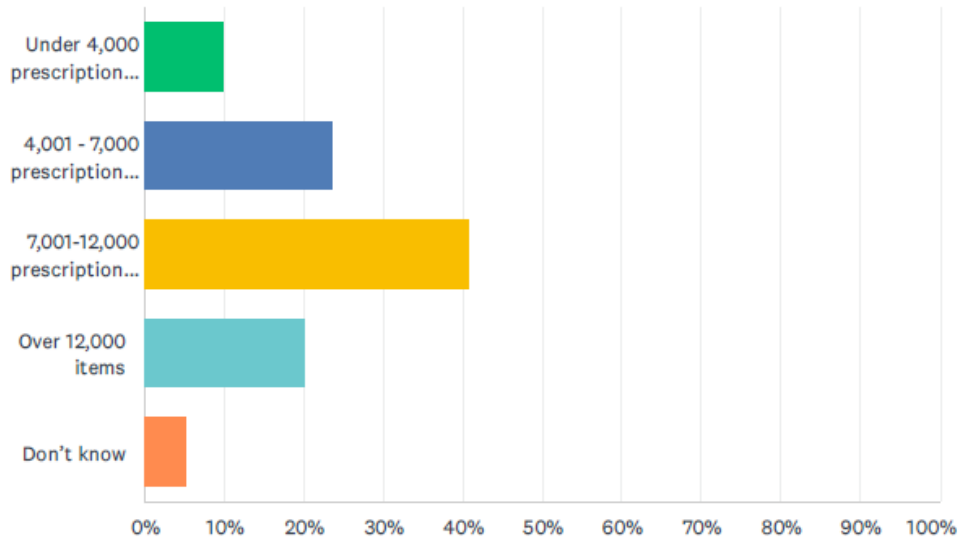
Q3 How many members of staff are typically working within your pharmacy at the same time?



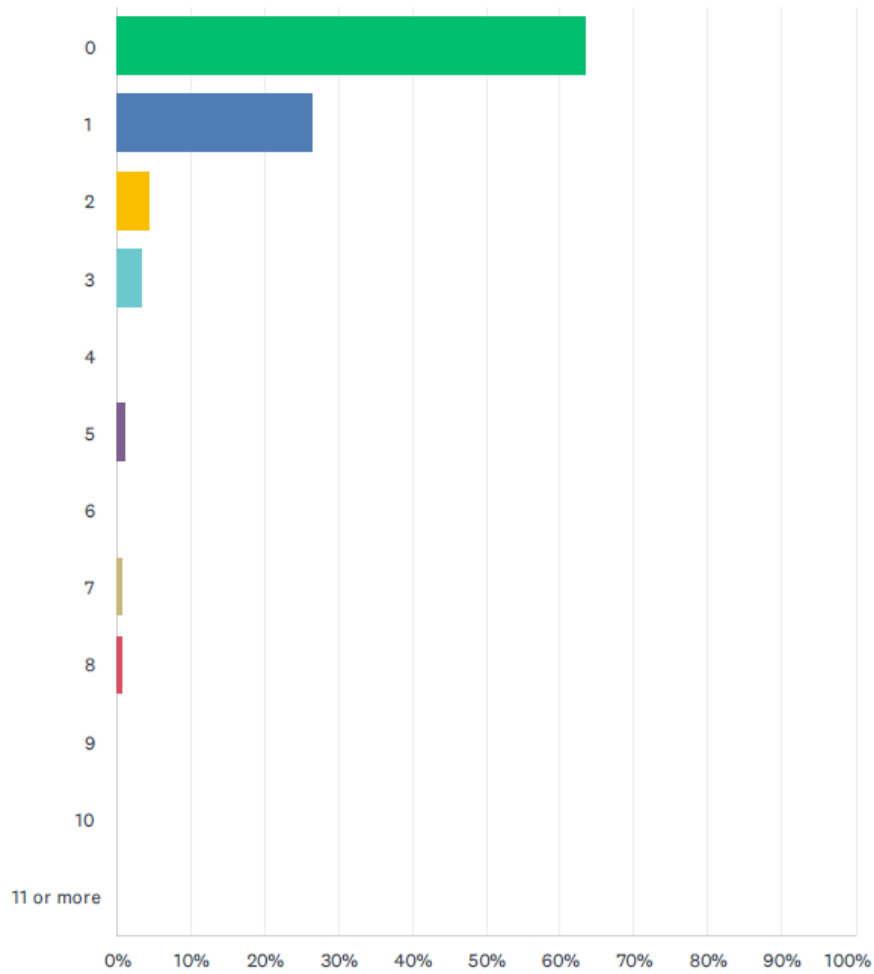

Q4 What is your typical approximate prescription volume within your pharmacy?



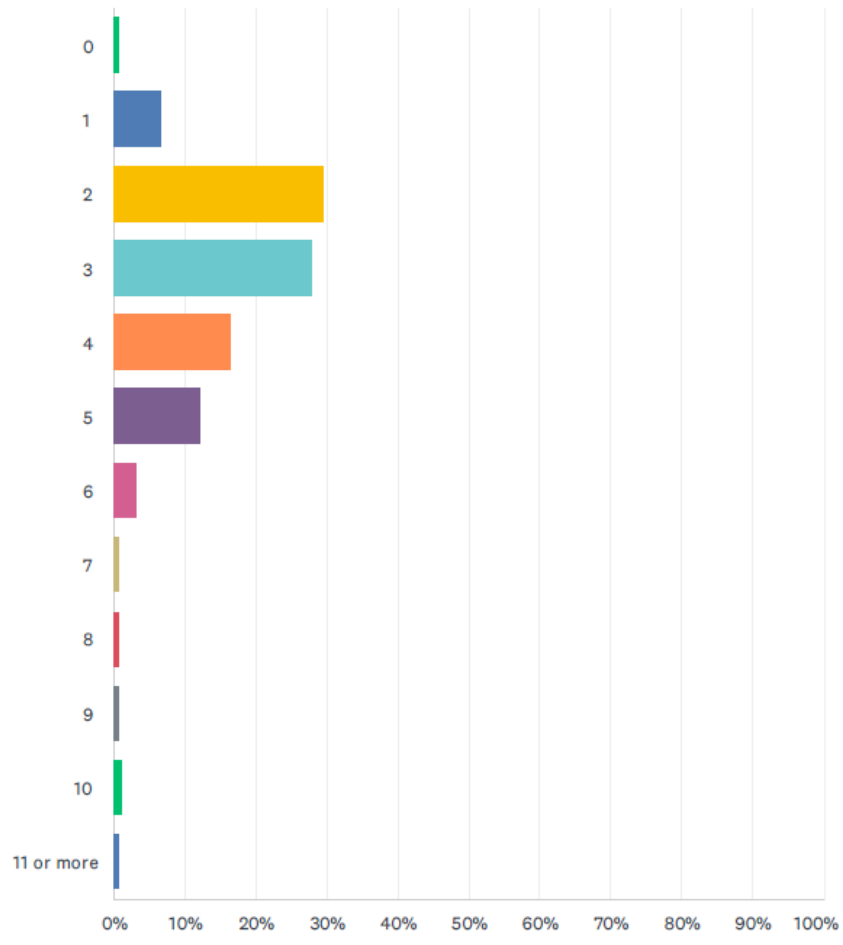
Q5 How many pharmacy-owned work smartphones are usually within the pharmacy on a typical day?

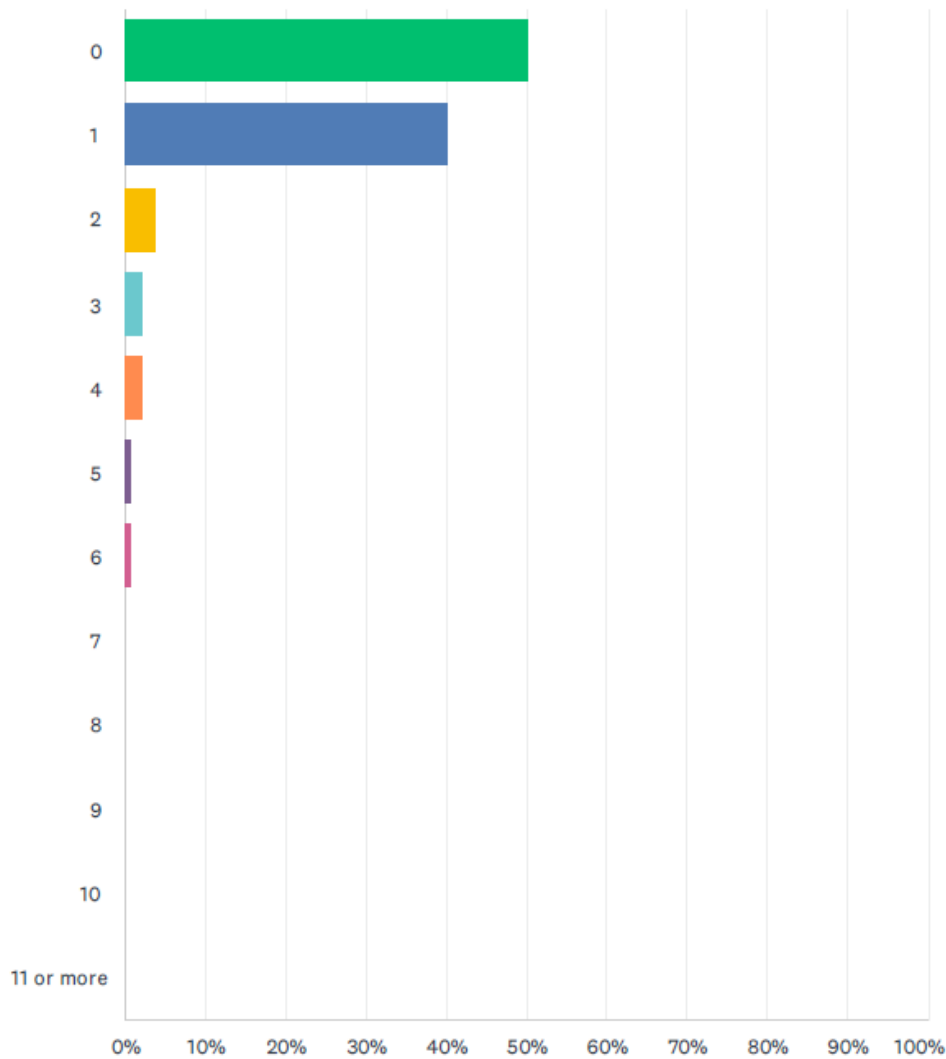
Q6 How many desktop computer terminals are connected to the PMR within the pharmacy?



The results suggest the staff member to terminal ratio is below 1:1

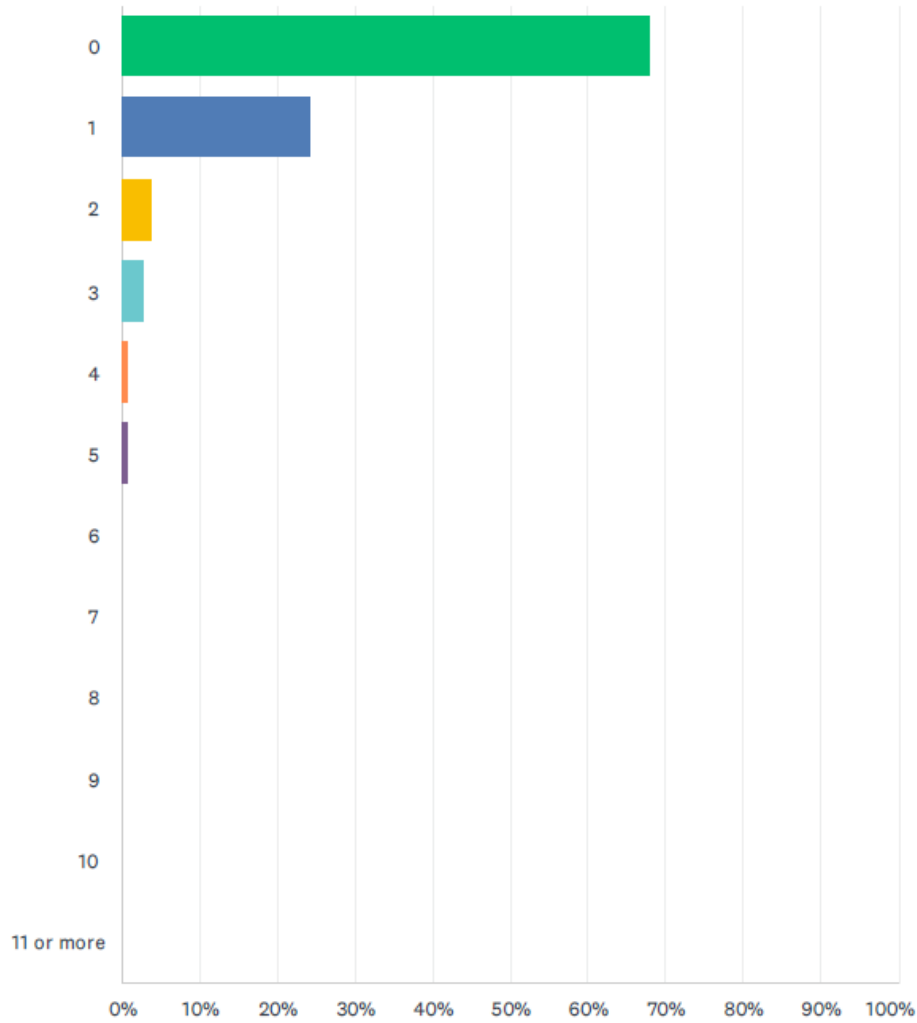

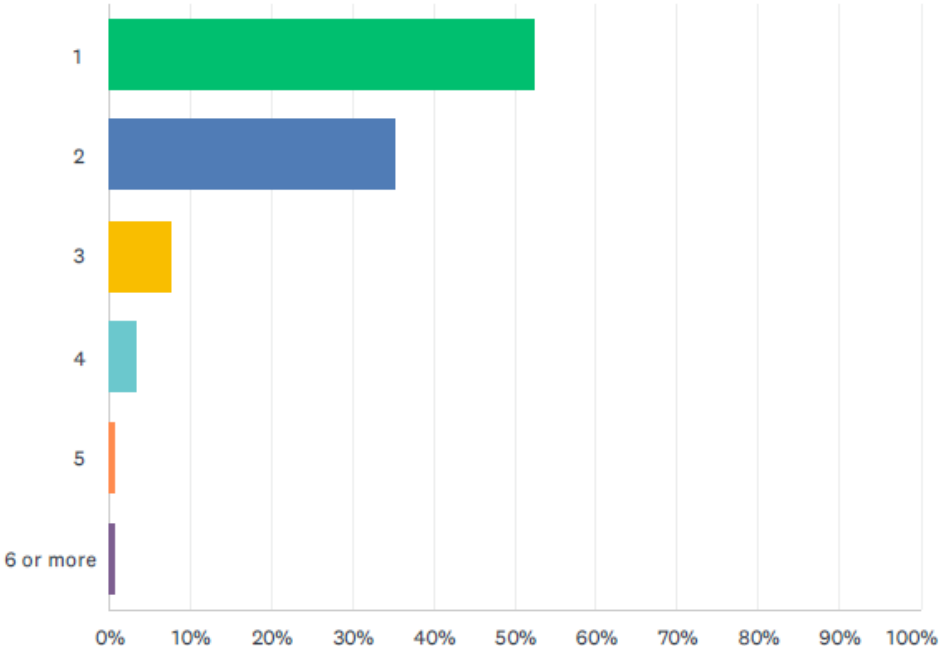
Q8 How many tablet-sized mobile devices does the pharmacy have?

Around a quarter said they had a single tablet device. Two thirds said they did not have a tablet device for work.

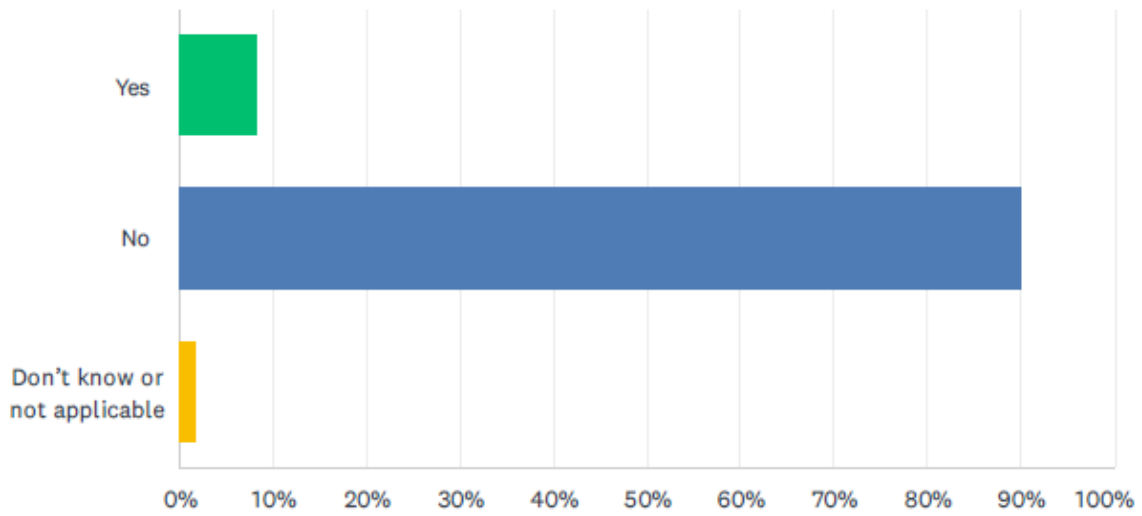
Q9 How many EPS token printers are used within the pharmacy?

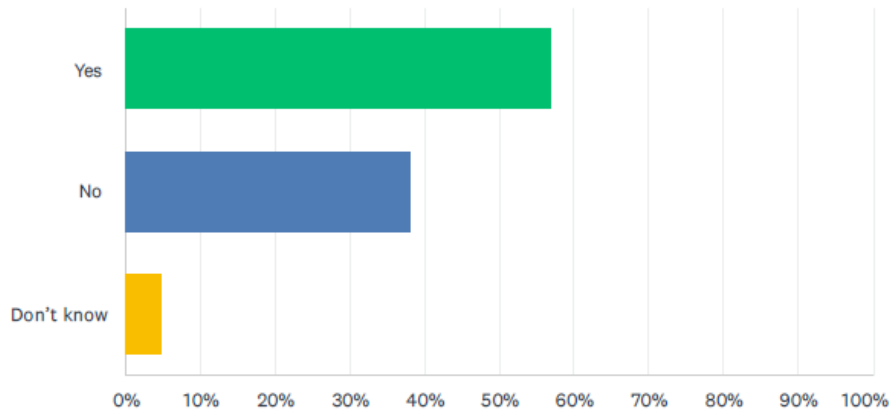

Does your pharmacy have dispensing robots?



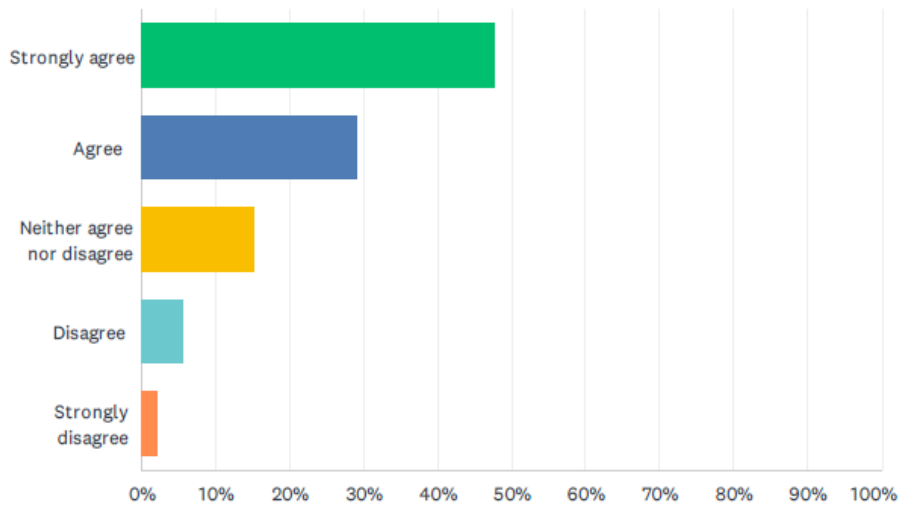

Q11 Does the space available within your pharmacy cause a problem for adding more desktop computer terminals?



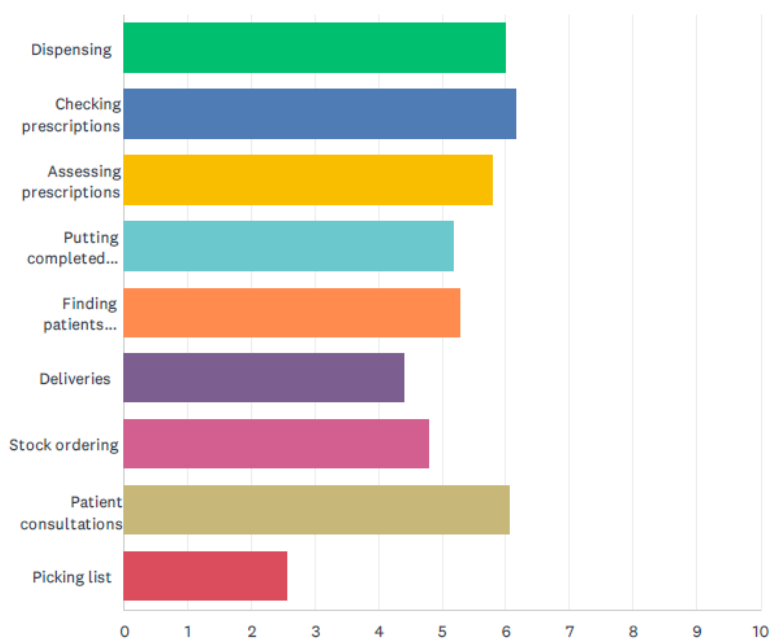

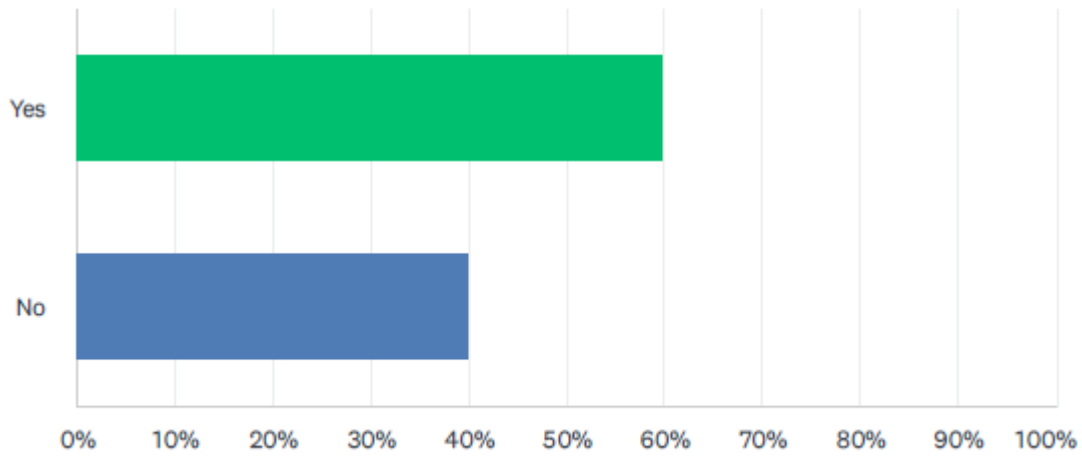

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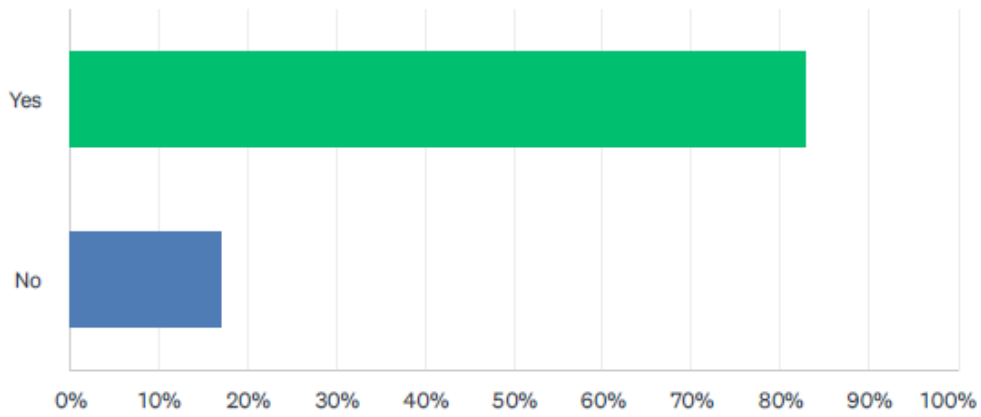

Are you aware of NHS paperless goals?



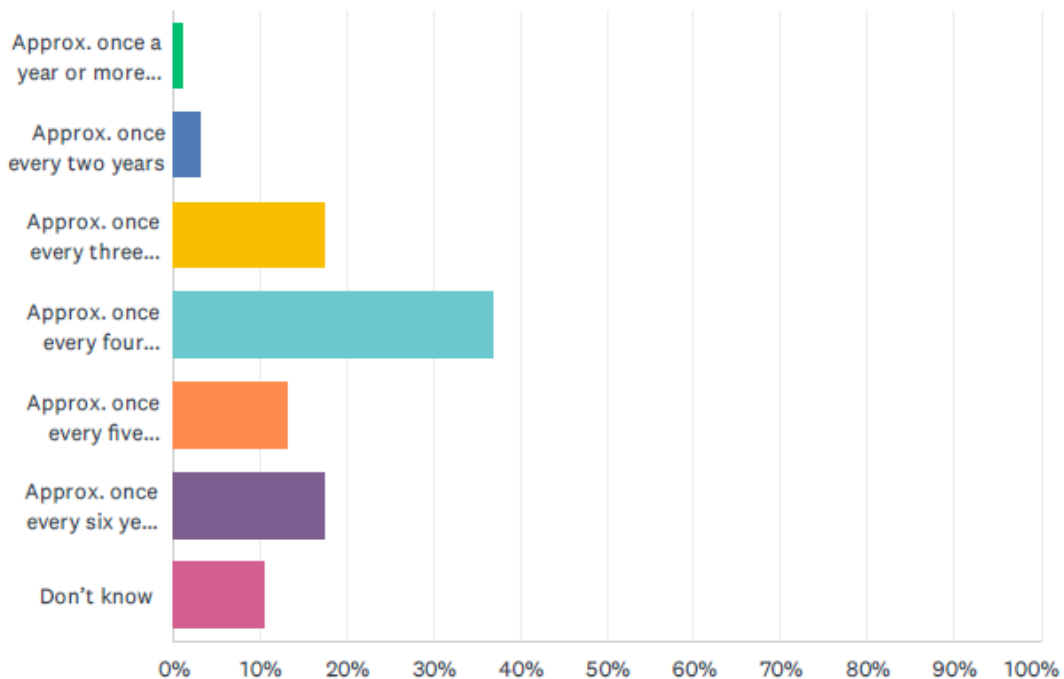

Q15 Are you supportive of the goal of a paperless pharmacy?



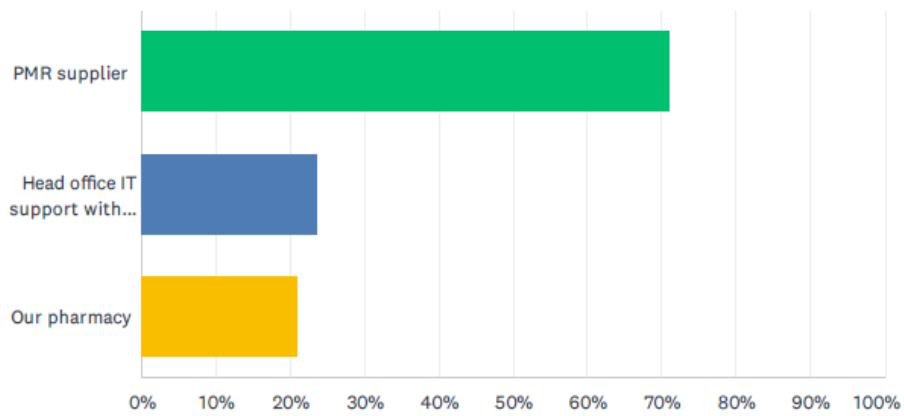

Q16 How frequently are computer desktop terminals replaced?



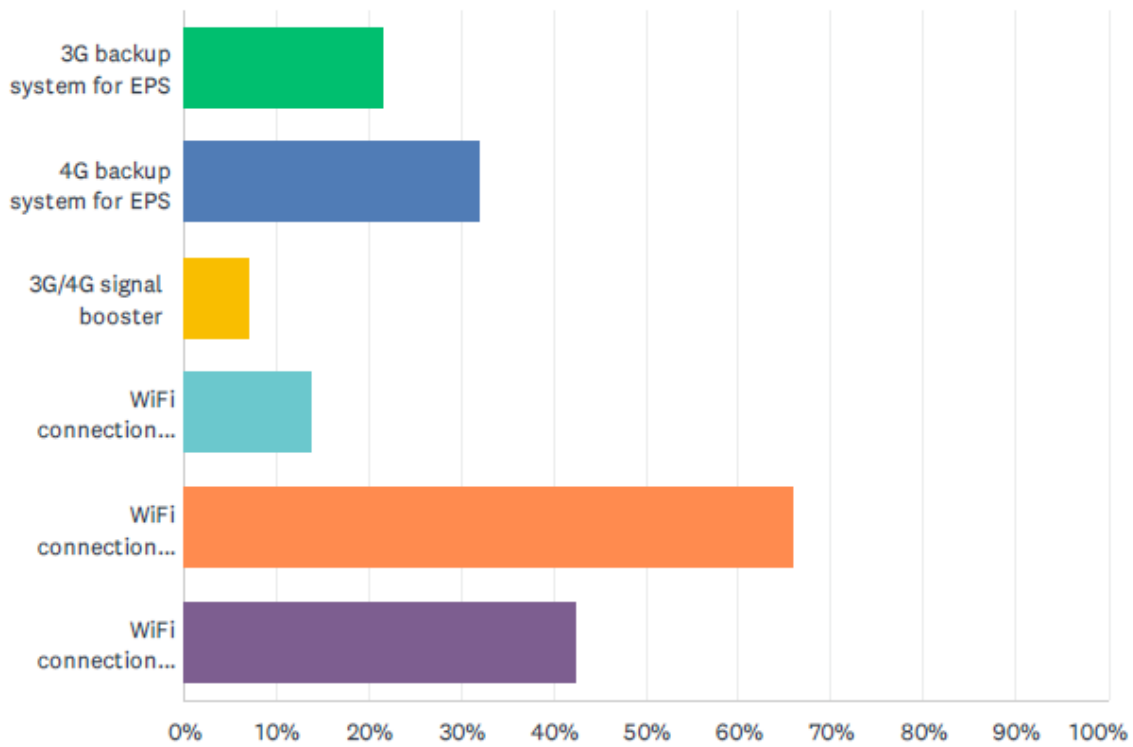

Q17 Who manages the PMR computer terminals? (tick against those that apply)



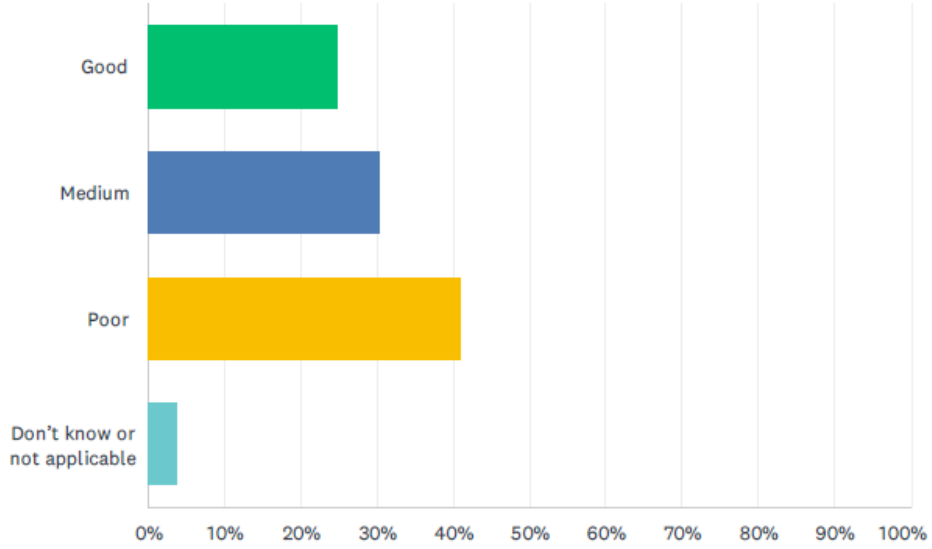

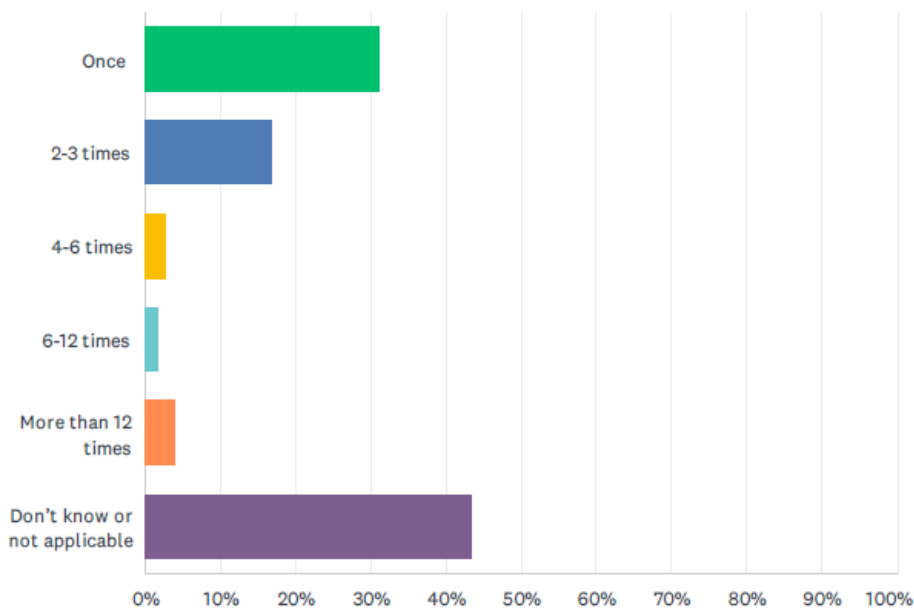

Q19 What experience do you have with mobile phone signal within your pharmacy?



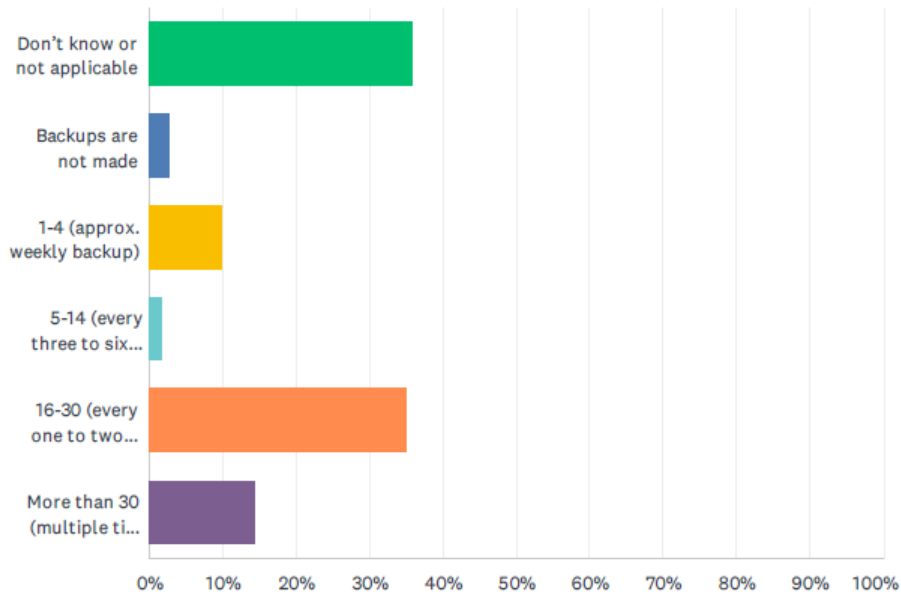
