

Anaphylaxis action

If a patient vaccinated in the pharmacy is thought to be suffering an anaphylactic reaction to the vaccination, while the pharmacist is assessing/treating the patient, another member of staff should immediately call for an ambulance:

- 1. Dial 999
- 2. Ask for the Ambulance service
- 3. Tell the Ambulance service: anaphylaxis following administration of a vaccine
- 4. Provide the pharmacy location details:
