Need a supply of oral contraception?

If you're already taking oral contraception (the pill) or looking for your first supply, you can arrange a confidential consultation at a local participating pharmacy.



Simply walk-in to the pharmacy and ask about their contraception service. Your GP or sexual health clinic can also refer you, but you don't have to be registered with a GP.

Your one-to-one consultation with a pharmacist will be held in a private room in the pharmacy.

If they agree that the pill is suitable for you, a supply can be made by the pharmacist.

The pharmacy contraception service is confidential, and free for everyone.

Unless you give permission, the pharmacist will not tell anyone about your consultation with them, including your GP.
