

Anaphylaxis action

If a patient vaccinated in the pharmacy is thought to be suffering an anaphylactic reaction to the vaccination, while the pharmacist/pharmacy technician is assessing/treating the patient, another member of staff should immediately call for an ambulance:

1. Dial 999
2. Ask for the Ambulance service
3. Tell the Ambulance service: anaphylaxis following administration of a vaccine
4. Provide the pharmacy location details:
5. Follow any instructions given by the Ambulance service operator
